TRUST & FIDUCIARY SECTOR QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

The purpose of this document is to enable organisations and their employees to chart a path through the wide range of professional programme qualifications available.

Likewise there are some abbreviations used for example, mention is made of the ICA suite of courses but there are too many to list individually.
